


What is A2E?

- Access to Experts (A2E) is a **free** service that's been set up to help groups navigate freshwater reforms.
- We put you in touch with people that can give advice / guidance in a range of areas – science, planning & policy, communications, complex facilitation, etc.
- Community and catchment groups, and collectives are eligible.
- Areas of the reform we're focussing on:
 - Mahinga kai
 - Nutrient limit setting
 - Sediment reduction
 - Wetland management
 - Implementing Te Mana o te Wai
- Available until June 2025
